Bryn Titli Windfarm Community Grant Scheme – Policy

All applicants applications will be considered equally

Allocation of funding is to be carried out twice a year:

September (phase 1) one

March (Phase 2) two

Opening and closing dates are as follows (unless otherwise stated):

Phase 1 one: 1st April – 31 July

Phase 2: two 1st October – 31 January

Only 1 one application per organisation can be submitted in 1 one phase

No more than £1,500 can be submitted in one phase

All applications must be made on the appropriate Grant application form (listed on the website), failure to do so will result in no submission of application/grant.

Each organisation applying must demonstrate the social benefits to the residents of St Harmon Community Council area resulting from the project

All applications must provide proof of purchase & expenditure (all receipts are to be provided to the Clerk)

All applicants must spend the money awarded on the items listed within the application.

Any grant funding that is misused e.g. not used for the purpose for which the grant was applied/awarded for will result in the monies being returned to the Council.

Any monies which is not spent within 12 months of the grant allocation date must be returned to the Community Council.

Any money that has been awarded to an organisation and is not fully spent must be returned to St Harmon Community Council for other organisations to benefit from.

The Community Council reserves the right to request additional information in support of the application for submission within one month prior to re-consideration.

Please see the Criteria required for Grant Applications.

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Criteria

Each organisation should show what section of the community it is likely to attract and benefit, and what benefit it will bring to the community.

Has your organisation applied for funding elsewhere?

Has the organisation made any financial provision for this project or any other future projects?

All applications should be supported by financial statements supporting the organisations financial viability.

Has the organisation attempted to raise funds by any fundraising activities within the last 12 months?

Has the organisation made any previous applications in the last three years if so what were the projects?

How much was the organisation awarded?

How many people are likely to be taking part in this project and what is its frequency?

Match funding is encouraged, where possible, by St Harmon Community Council
