Community Broadband Schemes – these are community led schemes working with a chosen supplier to bring fibre to the premises to an area using government funding. There is a neighbouring project in Rhayader and Nantmel.

Contacting the Community – The chosen supplier would let the community know of the opportunity via different channels such as social media, mail etc. The supplier would commonly seek guidance and support from the community council and project group in doing this. It is key for the supplier to make sure there is interest in the community for having fibre to the premises to make the project viable.

Building the network – the chosen supplier would build the network running fibre to the premises to each property that signs up. The supplier has access to Openreach ducts and poles but has to use their own cabling. The supplier will also put in ducts and erect poles where needed too.

Cost – Suppliers commonly state there will be no upfront cost for the consumer and then monthly costs range from £19.99 to £24.99 per month for 100 Mbps (dependant on the supplier), most suppliers also provide a landline package as an option also bringing over the landline number which is commonly around £9.99 per month.
