Qualifications to become a Councillor

A person is qualified to be elected and to be a councillor if he/she is

- a British, Commonwealth, Irish or European Union citizen and on the relevant day (that is, the day of nomination or election)
- he/she is 18 or over (qualifying age was reduced by section 17 of the 2006 Electoral Administration Act).

In addition, the person must meet at least one of the following criteria:

1. on the relevant day he must be on the electoral register for the community, or
2. during the whole of the twelve months before that day he has occupied as owner or tenant land or premises in the community, or
3. during the whole of the twelve months before that day his principal or only place of work has been in the community, or
4. during the whole of the twelve months before that day he has resided in the community or within three miles of it.
